



ADVENTURE PYRAMID



AIM

To encourage your group to look at what new ideas, activities & adventures they would like to include in their programme.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 10 Pictures of New Activities
- Equipment for an Obstacle Course

ESSENTIALS: PYRAMID OF NEW ADVENTURES



LEADER PREPARATION

Before running the activity you will need to print off 10 pictures of new activities which you could include in your programme for Anchors. Set up an obstacle course for your group to navigate and at the far end of the course, place 10 pictures of new activity ideas.



GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

- 1 Line up the children at one end of the obstacle course ready to play. *If playing with a large group, split into teams and have a complete set of pictures for each team playing.*
- 2 On go, one at a time they must work their way through the obstacle course, retrieve one of the pictures and make their way back to the group.
- 3 Repeat this with your group until all 10 pictures have been retrieved.
- 4 Once all 10 pictures have been collected, ask your group to now order them into a pyramid shape. Their favourite ideas should be at the top of the pyramid, with their least favourite ideas being at the bottom.
- 5 Encourage discussion on the different activity ideas. Use this time to understand what your group are interested in and take note of the final results to help plan your programme going forwards.
